

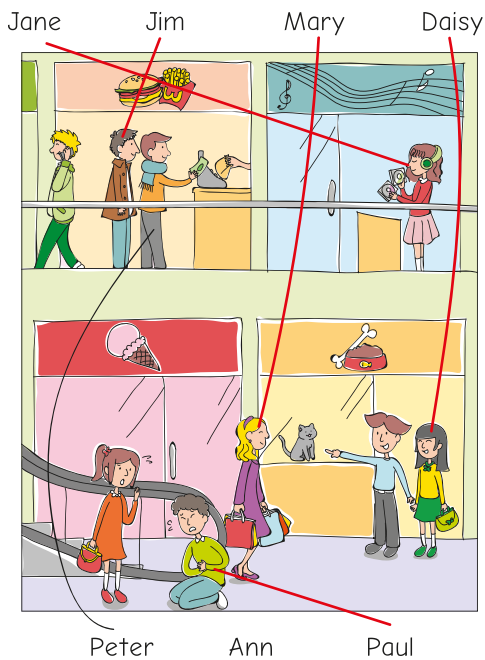

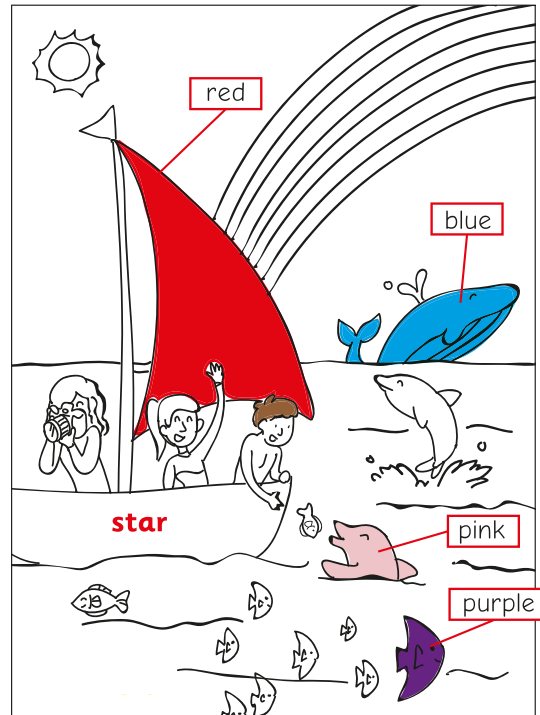

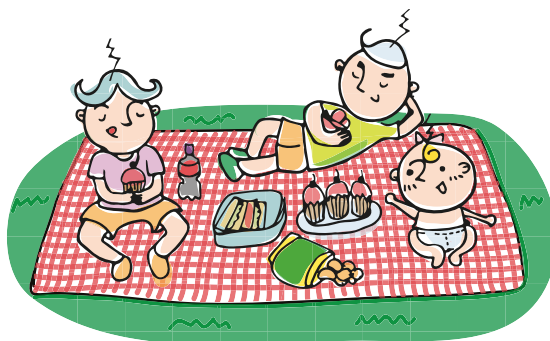

(Why?)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The man is the odd-one-out because the others show places you can visit or see.
