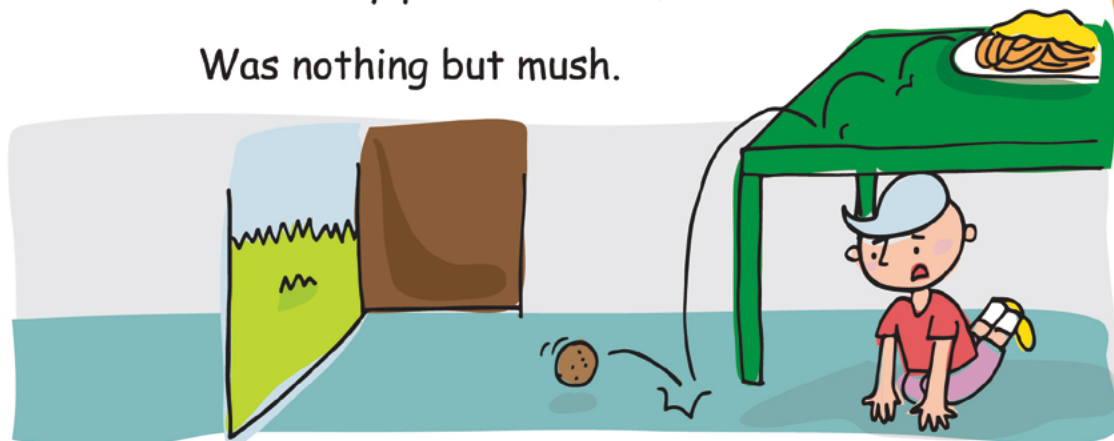
On Top of Spaghetti

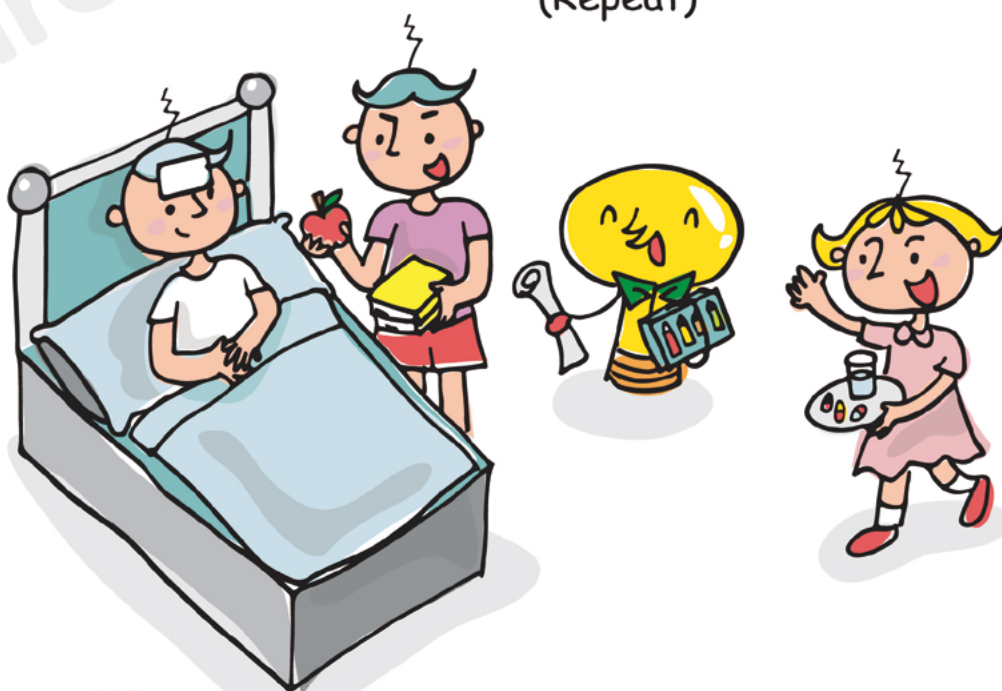
