

Introducing the Flyers Test

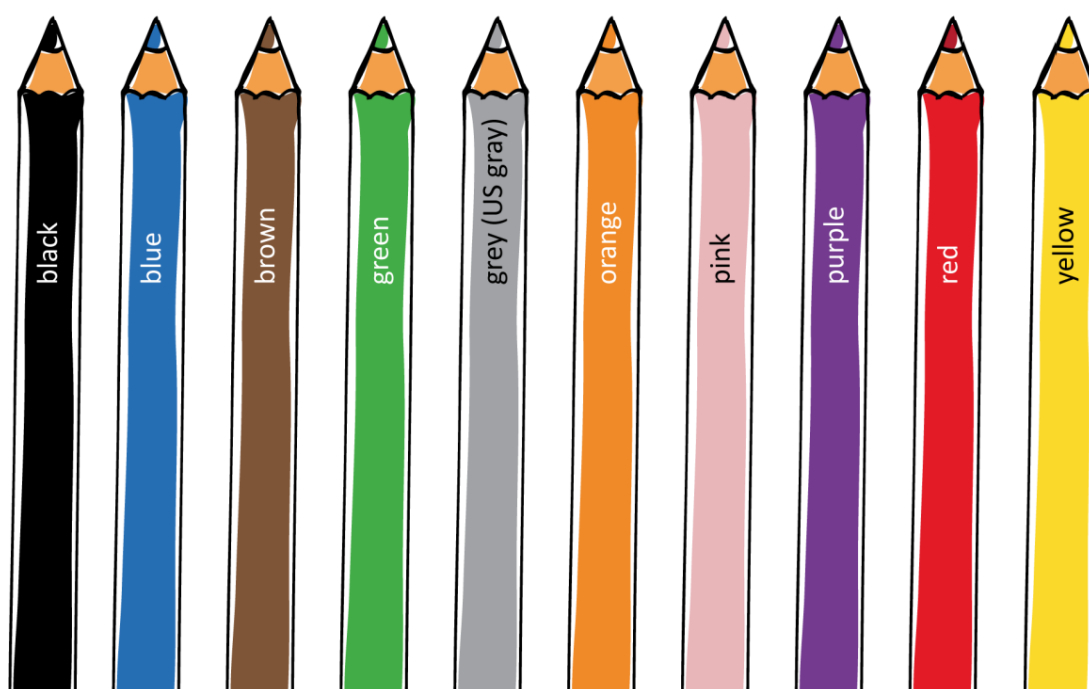
Cambridge English: Flyers is the third and highest level of the three **Cambridge English: Young Learners** tests. It corresponds to the A2 level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). It is recommended for learners from classes **P4 to PG** in Hong Kong. Young English learners aged between 9 and 11 worldwide take this test to receive certificates that showcase their achievement and progress in learning English.
