Cambridge English: Movers is the second level of the three **Cambridge English: Young Learners** tests. It corresponds to the pre-A1 level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). It is recommended for learners from classes **P2 to P4** in Hong Kong. Young English learners aged between 7 and 9 worldwide take this test to receive certificates that showcase their achievement and progress in learning English.

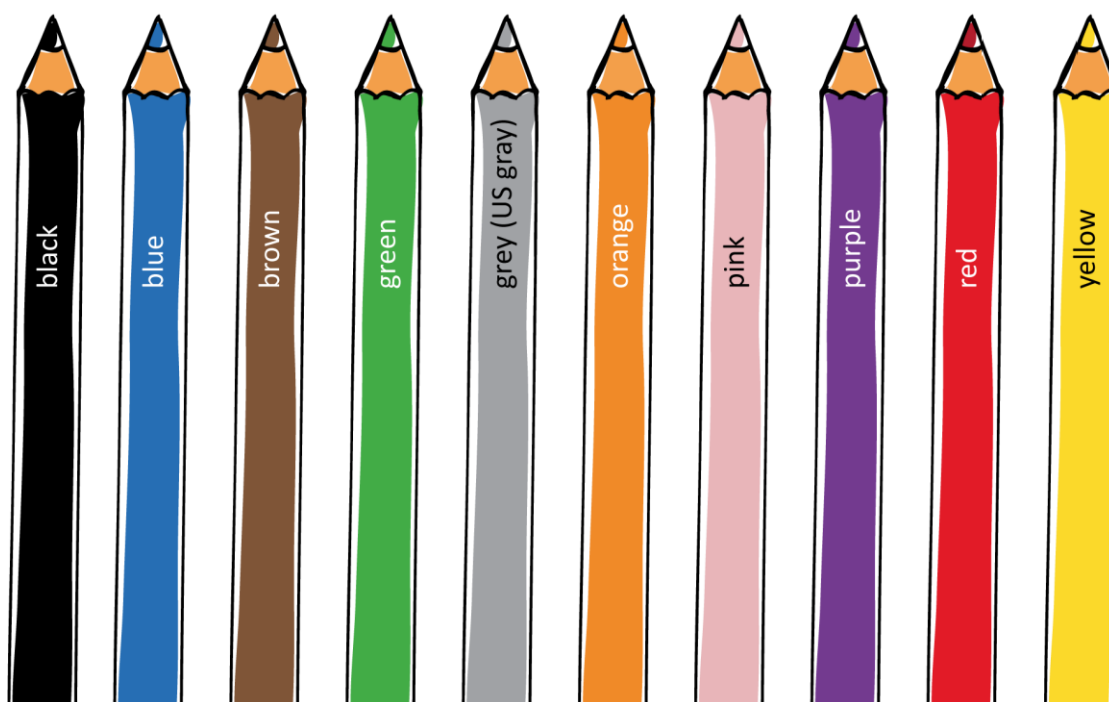
