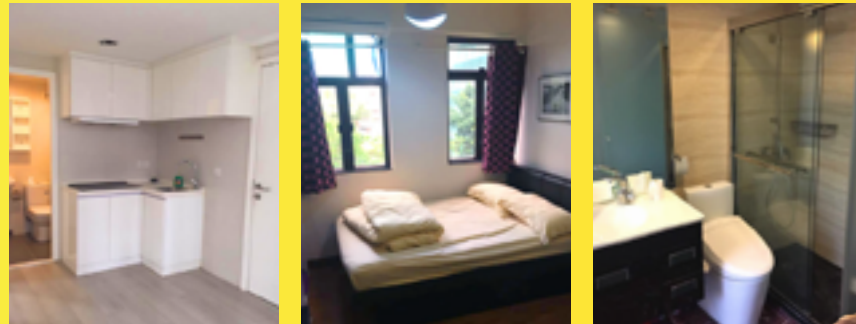

Work Visa Sponsorship

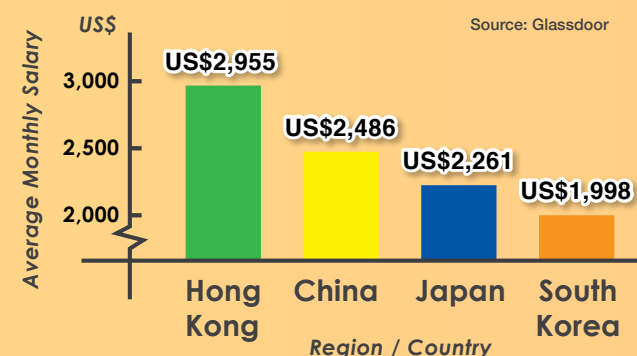
Programme Benefits

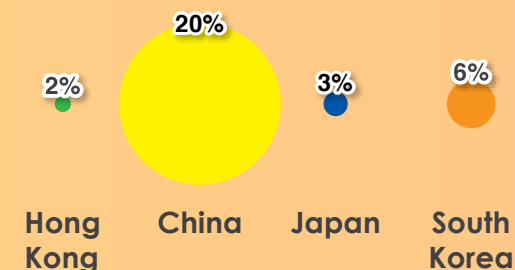
ESL teachers in Hong Kong enjoy a competitive salary while benefiting from the city's low tax rates:

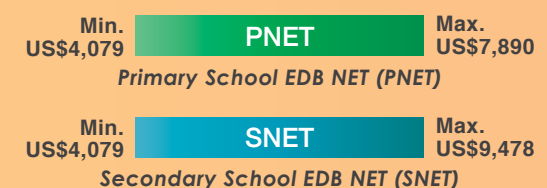
Tax Rates of Income Tax#
